




## **TOURNIKETIX**

The only specifically designed-for-purpose, reusable finger tourniquet.

- » Reusable
- » One size-fits-all
- » Achieving a totally exsanguinated finger
- » Bright blue or yellow highly visible tails make it totally unforgettable
- » Removable without rolling it over the wound or any risk of cutting skin
- » Environmentally friendly since it is reusable

For optimal use, follow the detailed instructions below. Placement of the Tourniketix is simple, easy and repeatable. It is used under local (LA) or locoregional (LRA) anaesthesia.



- **1.** The Tourniketix is prepared before placement by forming one or two loops, passing one, or both (as preferred), silicone beaded strand(s) through holes in the central crosspiece.
- 2. The Tourniketix is then placed on the digital pulp and tightened by pulling on the two strands.
- **3.** At this point, the Tourniketix is rolled down towards the base of the finger to obtain exsanguination efficacy.

If during this maneuvre the Tourniketix slip over skin without wrapping around itself then tourniquet tightness may not be maintained. Tourniketix has to wrap around itself to reach finger base and then to maintain finger vascular tightness during surgery.

**4.** The surgical procedure (suture, exploration, etc.) may begin.

**5.** Removing it is easy: simply pull on the central crosspiece to loosen and remove the tourniquet. It can be sterilised and reused.

When a totally bloodless field is not required, the Tourniketix can be used with a single loop: the arm is held above heart level for a few minutes and the It is applied directly to the base of the finger.


NB1 - Do not use Tourniketix on small fingers.

NB2 - Do not use Tourniketix in paediatric cases. These contra-indication are related to Tourniketix dimentional characteristics.

NB3 - Do not clamp Tourniketix with a metallic instrument to maintain this finger tourniquet, this may initiate small cuts into silicone resulting in potential secondary rupture.
